Mar-20	Butterfield Way Clayton Close	Ash	William Butterfield who restored the church in 1847; John Richard Clayton of Clayton & Bell who designed & manufactured the stained glass windows in the church;
Dec-20	Bartlett Close	Bartlett Close	Proposed by Staple Parish Council after 'Arthur Bartlett who left the ground to his family was Deacon of Barnsole Chapel, where he ran a large Sunday School for local village children. He was in Staple Home Guard during the last war, served on Staple Parish and Village Hall Committees for many years and was also Governor of the local Primary School until it closed'.
Mar-21	Alliss Gardens	Sandwich	after the deceased golfer, Peter Alliss 1931-2020. Permission obtained from family.
Jun-21	Walter Hammond Close	Dover	after the England cricketer, born in Dover 1903-1965
Jun-21	Dame Vera Lynn Way	Dover	<b>RENAME:</b> of Cliff Path. After the deceased singer/actress 1917-2020. Permission obtained from daughter
Sep-22	Bedwell Close Whyman Close	Deal	Proposed by Addelam History Research Group via Cllr Helen Williams. Named after two landowners/farmers, John Bedwell and James Whyman as per the 1843 Tithe Map
Aug-23	Pearson Road	Aylesham	in reference to Pearson & Dorman Long Ltd who modernised the colliery and built Aylesham village
Oct-23	Pinder Street	Betteshanger	Captain John William Pinder DFC (14 February 1898 – 16 August 1920) was a British First World War flying ace who flew for the Royal Navy Air Service, and later the Royal Air Force. He was born in Deal.
Apr-24	Wyborn Drive Bargrave Lane Edgar Place Banks Way	Sholden	in keeping with the history of the parish, these are all former owners of the nearby listed building Sholden Hall, formerly Lodge (pre 1950).
Sep-24	Telford Tunnel Road	Dover	"a nod to the water tunnels designed by Thomas Telford that run beneath it"
Jan-25	Pewtner Drive Webster Street Iggulden Close Johnson Lane Royce Drive Jolliffe Street	Sholden	as with the names used in Phase 1A, these all have links to the history of Sholden Hall
Mar-25	Silk Road Carrier Square Belsey Court Ansell Drive Bristow Close Horn Lane Morris Close Scott Way Gardener Lane	Wingham	As proposed by Wingham Parish Council, all surnames of Wingham residents who are named on the war memorial.
May-25	Marshall Lane Fitzwilliam Row	Deal	in respect of Billy Marshall, one of the original miners to come to Kent in the 1920's and later a councillor on Deal Town Council; in respect of Edward Francis Fitzwilliam, a composer and music director, born in Deal in 1824;
