## THE 149<sup>TH</sup> OPEN - VARIOUS ROADS, SANDWICH & DEAL

### (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC)

#### **TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

For the safety of the public by avoiding congestion and ensuring smooth traffic flows during The 149<sup>th</sup> Open (Golf Championship), Kent County Council has made an Order to prohibit certain traffic on various roads in and near Sandwich and Deal so that they become one-way.

The following roads will become one-way only, in the direction shown.

Where stated, the direction of travel on certain roads will be reversed during the day, so that traffic is routed towards the event in the morning and away from the event in the afternoons, known as 'Tidal Flow'.

**UPPER STRAND STREET, SANDWICH** – will become one-way only between the junctions with High Street and Knightrider Street

- 06:00 to 14:00 hours eastbound only
- 14:00 to 22:00 hours westbound only

#### KNIGHTRIDER STREET, SANDWICH

- 06:00 to 14:00 hours will become one-way southbound only, from the junction with Upper Strand Street to the junction with Sandown Road
- 14:00 to 22:00 hours will become one-way northbound only from the junction with Sandown Road to The Quay

SANDOWN ROAD, SANDWICH – will become one-way only between the junctions with Knightrider Street and St George's Road

- 06:00 to 14:00 hours eastbound only
- 14:00 to 22:00 hours westbound only

ETHELBERT ROAD, DEAL – will become one-way, eastbound only between the junctions with Golf Road and Canute Road at all times

PIKE ROAD, TILMANSTONE – will become one-way, southbound only from Thornton Road to the entrance of Ovenden Recycling Centre

• from 14:00 to 22:00 hours

VENSON ROAD, TILMANSTONE – will become one-way, westbound only from a point 50 metres from A256 Whitfield Bypass to the southern junction with Pike Road / Thornton Road at all times.

This Order comes into force from Sunday 11 July 2021 and remains valid until conclusion of The 149<sup>th</sup> Open, no later than Monday 19 July 2021.
