THE 149TH OPEN –

VARIOUS ROADS, SANDWICH

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

For the safety of the public by avoiding congestion and ensuring smooth traffic flows during The 149th Open (Golf Championship), Kent County Council has made an Order to prohibit waiting on various roads in the Sandwich, Deal and surrounding areas.

On the roads in Sandwich defined below

- Waiting will be prohibited at any time
- Loading and unloading will be prohibited between 06:00 hours and 22:00 hours each day, except where otherwise stated

The restrictions apply on both sides of each road unless otherwise indicated.

ANCIENT HIGHWAY, SANDWICH BAY – for its entire length

This includes those sections of the Ancient Highway (EE245) that coincide with the metalled road, i.e.

- Between Waldershare Avenue and Dickson's Corner
- Chequers Public House northwards for a distance of approximately 335 metres.

ASH ROAD – for its entire length

DEAL ROAD / DOVER ROAD – from the junction with A258 Deal Road to where it becomes New Street

KNIGHTRIDER STREET – between the junctions with The Quay and Sandown Road

MONKS WAY – for its entire length

NEW STREET – between the junctions with Dover Road and Galliard Street.
The prohibition of loading and unloading does not apply to buses

THE QUAY – for its entire length, with the exception of the existing limited waiting bays

RAMSGATE ROAD – between the junctions with A256 Sandwich Bypass and The Quay

SANDOWN ROAD – between the junctions with St George’s Road and Knightrider Street

STRAND STREET – for its entire length, but with the following exceptions

- **The parking bay on the northern side, from a point in line with the eastern flank wall of 1-3 Guestling Mill Court to a point opposite the eastern boundary of 67 Strand Street.**
- **The northern side, from opposite the junction with The Butts for 70 metres westwards**
- **The southern side, from the junction with The Butts for 30 metres westwards**

UPPER STRAND STREET – for its entire length

This Order comes into force from Sunday 11 July 2021 and remains valid until conclusion of The 149th Open, no later than Monday 19 July 2021.

Whilst in force, this Order over-rides any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to the sections of roads defined above.
